Rustic Acorn Marble Necklace or Ornament

CRAFT SUPPLIES

- Acorn caps
- Marbles
- Drill
- Twine
- Glue gun and glue sticks

STEP 1- First; go on a nature hunt to find some acorn caps. Look on the ground for fallen acorns, as there are many types of Oak trees around your neighborhoods.

STEP 2- Play with your marbles and acorn caps to see which acorn caps will fit a marble. Not all acorn caps will work. Some acorn caps are too big for marbles while others are too small. Some large acorn caps will fit a shooter marble if you would like to make your acorn marble necklace or ornaments a little larger.

STEP 3 – *Adult supervision and power tools needed. Drill two holes into the acorn cap on either side of the stem.



STEP 4- String twine onto each acorn cap to make a hanger for each acorn necklace or ornament. Cut as many 6 to 10 inch sections of twine as you need for the number of acorn caps and marbles that you have paired together.

STEP 5- To do this, thread a 6 to 10 inch section of jute twine through the holes you pre-drilled into the acorn the cap and tie it together so that the knot is on the inside of the acorn marble ornament.

STEP 6- Use a glue gun to place a dollop of glue inside the acorn cap and quickly place a marble into it before the glue dries.

*You can wear as a necklace or hang on outside trees to add a little décor and sparkle.
