



How to Make This Printable Shark Puppet

Print the puppets. We used heavier print paper 120gsm, but regular print paper will work too (it will just be more prone to "wear and tear").



If you printed the black and white version, we recommend you color it in before you cut out the pieces.



Cut out the straps.



Don't cut the shark yet as you'll need to fold it as marked by lines.

Make 3 folds along the lines on the printable.







Now that you made the folds, you can cut out the shark.



Reinforce the folds.



Glue the straps on the back of the shark (over the inside of the mouthpart). One on top and one on bottom.



All done! Your printable shark puppet craft is complete! This little sharky is now ready to take a bite at anything that crosses its path.
